1,320 BAPTISMS

400 Pathfinders were registered to be baptized before Camporee began. Those baptized represented 18 countries and 9 divisions.

\$21 Million ECONOMICAL IMPACT ON THE CITY OF OSHKOSH

The Oshkosh Walmart set new sales records because of Pathfinders.

9,400 BIBLES COLLECTED

Through Bible & a Buck, each Pathfinder was encouraged to bring one Bible and one dollar to support the distribution of Bibles in areas where people can't afford them.

3 1/2 YEARS TO WRITE AND PRODUCE SCRIPT

It took 3 1/2 years To write and produce the David Story script and music.

300 FT. OF FABRIC - LARGEST SCARF/SLIDE

800 pounds of fabric, 2,252,544 stitches, and 300+ volunteers created the world's largest scarf.

Including the slide (500 pounds), the 60 foot truss (1800 pounds), and the two bars above (1600 pounds), there were approximately 12,700 pounds hanging in the air.

The top of the scarf was held approximately 115 feet in the air by two 90 ton cranes



600 MASTER GUIDES INVESTED

A very special Master Guide pin is created just for the International Camporee every 5 years.

29 CORE ACTORS

In the David story evening play, there were also 40+ extras. Saturday night had the largest number of extra actors together on stage (36).

13,309 PEOPLE IN THE LARGEST HUMAN CROSS

At the Chosen International Camporee, attendees broke the 13,266 person record fo the world's largest human cross on Sabbath morning.

4+ YEARS TO DEVELOP 2024 THEME & LOGO

The 2024 theme is "Believe the Promise", and the Bible story will explore the lives of Moses and Miriam.

\$68,533 RAISED

\$68,533 was raised through Sabbath offerings for Bible & Buck, Adventist World Aviation, and Pathfinder Evangelism in Cuba. The largest online donation was \$4,900, and the largest cash donation was \$1,000.
