International Prayer Coordinator

Job Overview

The International Prayer Coordinator is responsible to connect international participants that will pray in different languages at the Nighttime Program.

Responsibilities and Duties

Main duties for this position include but are not limited to:

- 1. Work with the International Guest Services Director to be informed of the names of Pathfinders who would like to pray at the Nighttime Program.
- 2. Contact international group leaders to find new Pathfinders to pray in diverse languages, creating a grid of diversity for each night, according to the number of prayers agreed with the Nighttime Program Director. More diverse is always better.
- 3. Create and share a clear schedule of prayers.
- 4. Remind the Participants to be behind the stage at least 60 minutes before the program starts, to receive instructions, answer questions, get comfortable, and pray for their participation.
- 5. Have always a plan B, C, and D if a Pathfinder doesn't show up.

Qualifications

- Love for God and Pathfinder Clubs.
- NAD member with a current background check approved by your Conference.
- Experience with Pathfinder Club practices.
- Friendly to different cultures.
- Master English language and ideally another language.

Schedule

- 1 year BTC: Meet with the team of volunteers and receive training.
- 1 year BTC: Confirm available international volunteers for prayer and start contacting international groups that have already confirmed their attendance.
- At the Camporee: Complete the schedule developed during the last year, the backup plans, and get in contact with all the Pathfinders that will participate and their leaders.
