If your club is planning to leave items behind, please consider donating it by placing it in one of the Donation Trailers, which will be located at each **Union exit** from their camping area.

These items, in good condition, along with non-perishable food items will be donated to low-income and homeless families in the Gillette, WY community through food pantries, thrift stores, soup kitchen, shelters, etc.

Equipment accepted in good condition:

Camping gear such as tents, shelters, sleeping bags, chairs, coolers, propane tanks, etc.

Unopened Non-perishable food items accepted:

Canned or boxed food, produce such as potatoes, watermelon, unopened bread products, juice boxes, water bottles, etc.

Items NOT ACCEPTED:

We will not accept any open/unsealed food items, such as milk, bread, etc., or broken equipment.

Collection sites, days & times:

- Sites: One trailer located at each UNION camping area exit. These trailers will be on-site all week.
- Days & Times:
Tuesday – Friday: 10am - 3pm
Saturday: 2pm – 12 midnight
Sunday: 7:00am – all day
