

TLT Ice Sales Volunteer Duties

Duties Include the Following:

- 8:00am-9:00am - Loading small ice containers from semi, setting up ice stand with canopy, table, and signs.
- 9:00am-6:00pm - Load customers club wagons or their arms with the number of bags of ice ordered.
- At the end of the day, the ice containers would be locked up and canopies brought down with tables, signs and cash register taken inside.
- One TLT would run the cash register and take cash only for ice ordered before the loading of ice takes place.
- Receipts would be given by TLT at the cash register.

Camporee will Supply the following:

- Gloves, tables, signs, and canopies.
- Cash register with receipt capabilities and start up cash of \$75 at each stand.
- Adults from the Camporee Finance department assigned to pick up the money each evening.
- Locks for the semis and small ice containers.

Hours for TLTs to volunteer Monday through Friday to get their pin

- 8:00-9:00am each morning
- 8:00am-12:00pm
- 12:00pm-4:00pm
- 4:00pm-6:00pm / 2 times a week
- TLTs must volunteer at least 4 hours to receive the pin
- To receive a T-shirt after the camporee, TLTs must volunteer 12 hours total

Ice Sale Coordinators will work with TLTs

- Ice Sale Coordinators will work with TLTs who want to come each morning to set up and load small ice containers for 1 hour each day.
- Ice Sale Coordinators are flexible in hours and would make TLTs time fit with their club activities and schedules for each day.
- Ice Sale Coordinators will have an adult volunteer at each location while the ice stands are open.
