Mobile Food Prep Vehicle (Truck/Trailer) Requirements

Campbell County Fire Dept. enforces the International Fire Code, which, as of 2021, includes requirements for Mobile Food Preparation Vehicles (Food Trucks). The code language can be found in IFC Chapter 319.

If you intend to operate a Food Truck in Campbell County, WY you are responsible for making certain all of your cooking, fuel systems and fire safety equipment are being serviced as required by the Fire Code. Once completed, call (307) 682-5319 to schedule your annual inspection.

Inspection Items:

Grease Laden Vapors

- *Cooking equipment that produces grease-laden vapors shall be provided with a kitchen exhaust hood in accordance with Section 606 (IFC 319.3)*

Exhaust Hood

- Cleaning of the hood and inspection of the fire suppression system within the hood is required every 6 months (IFC Table 606.3.3.1).

Fire Protection for Cooking Equipment

- *Cooking equipment shall be protected by automatic fire-extinguishing system in accordance with Section 904.13 (IFC 319.4.1)*

Fire Extinguishers (Type ABC & K)

- Portable fire extinguishers must be used as a secondary back up. They must be inspected annually. They shall comply with IFC 906.

LP-Gas Alarms

- *A listed LP-gas alarm shall be installed within the vehicle in the vicinity of LP-gas system components, in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. (IFC 319.8.5)*

LP-Gas Containers

- *The maximum aggregate capacity of LP-gas containers transported on the vehicle and used to fuel cooking appliances only shall not exceed 200 pounds propane capacity. (IFC 319.8.1)*

Annual Leakage Test

- *LP-gas containers installed on the vehicle and fuel-gas piping systems shall be inspected annually by an approved inspection agency or a company that is registered with the US Department of Transportation to requalify LP-gas cylinders, to ensure that system components are free from damage, suitable for the intended service and not subject to leaking. (IFC 319.10.3)*

The above list does not include all provisions of 2021 IFC Section 319

All mobile food preparation vehicles (trucks/trailers) working within Campbell County shall be expected to comply with all requirements of this code. Free access to more information can be found at
